Installation

The Digital Frog 2 requires QuickTime. We also recommend that you copy The Digital Frog 2 application from the CD to the hard drive. (You can run it directly from the CD, but it will run more slowly.)

If QuickTime 2.1.2 or later is not already installed:

- 1. Insert the disc into the CD-ROM drive.
- 2. Double click on the Digital Frog 2 CD-ROM icon to view the contents of the CD.
- 3. Double click on QuickTime 3.0 folder.
- 4. Double click on Install QuickTime.
- 5. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the QuickTime installation.

To install The Digital Frog 2:

- 1. Drag **The Digital Frog 2** icon from the CD to the hard drive.
- 2. Double click on the copied **The Digital Frog 2** icon to run the program.

Troubleshooting

If your Mac has less than 8 MB of RAM, you might need to turn off unnecessary extensions and reduce the application size to 5000 K. If you get the message **Could not find QuickTimeLib** while launching the program, your computer might be low on memory; reducing the application size will help.

To reduce the application size:

- 1. Click on The Digital Frog 2 icon to select it.
- 2. Choose **Get Info** from the **File** menu.
- 3. Change the Preferred Size to 5000 K.
